- a. Copies of all relevant certificates/notification of results which have been indicated on the application form. These must be duly certified as true copies of the originals by a recognized Commissioner of Oaths.
- b. Where applicable, a copy of registration certificate with the Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi or an equivalent regulatory body and a current registration receipt
- c. Original proof of availability of funds for training i.e. official sponsorship letter or bank statements of the applicant.
- d. Copy of a bank deposit slip showing the name of the applicant and the amount of application fee paid.
